Trabuco Canyon Little League is pleased to form All-Star teams, who will compete in District 68's All-Star Tournaments:

Age 9U All-Stars | Age 10U All-Stars | Age 11U All-Stars | 12 U All-Stars

Players between the Little League Ages of 7 to 12 years old may be eligible for team selection. **Parents are requested to review, sign, and return this Form to their coaches, and the coaches shall return it to the President by Saturday, May 2, 2026.** Teams may be eliminated if a minimum number of players have not committed.

All Star Format

TCLL All Star teams compete in a double-elimination Tournament hosted by District 68. Field locations are determined by District 68.

The selection of the individual TCLL teams, the dates of the Tournament, as well as any additional Tournaments (based on successful advancement), are dependent upon the individual levels of play.

All-Star Experience

The All-Star experience differs from the Regular Season experience. All-Star teams need to quickly assemble and prepare for a demanding, competitive tournament against the best players in our District. Emphasis is placed upon fielding the best lineup to position a TCLL victory.

Practices are frequent and rigorous. At the Manager's determination, teams may practice up to six (6) days per week, inclusive of Sunday.

Unlike the Regular Season, there is no 'minimum play' requirement for defensive outs in the field. A player may receive only one (1) at-bat per game and players may also be asked to play positions and fulfill roles that are different than their regular season roles.

All-Star Team Selection

Players are selected for the All-Star team based on their performance through the 2026 Season, **as well as their agreed commitment to the team throughout the All-Star Tournament.**

Player eligibility requirements include:

- Participation in minimum 8 of their Regular Season, local League Tournament and where applicable, District 68 Tournament of Champions games (exception for physician noted injury);
- Completion of the Parental Commitment Form (this document) prior to the All-Star Selection Meeting.
- Commitment to the team, and disclosure of any known conflicts that could impact the team or participation with team practices, scrimmages, or games.

Players are voted by the division coaches, with the All-Star Manager making additional selections.

Full details to the process for the selection of the All-Star Manager and Team Players may be found in the TCLL Local Rules.

All-Star Commitment

Players are expected to prioritize their commitment to the All-Star Team throughout the duration of the team's All-Star play by attending all team games, practices, and team building events.

To assist with the team evaluation process, parents are asked to disclose any known potential conflicts – due to family events (e.g. graduations, vacations, weddings, etc.) or any other known events, on this registration form.

All-Star Fees

An All-Star participation fee of \$180 is requested from each player. The fee is used to offset the additional costs incurred by the league during the All-Star season, such as uniforms, equipment, all-star events, tournament supplies, etc.

If a family needs to request a waiver of the fee, they can contact the TCLL Tournament Director (president@tcll.org) for consideration.
